

Apple iPhone 6 Plus Review

The iPhone 6 Plus is by far the biggest of its kind, which is the undoubtedly the first thing that Apple users will notice. There are, however, quite a few new and interesting features that this phone has to offer and they are definitely worth taking a close look at. If you have been thinking about upgrading from the 5s or even want to make the switch from an Android handset, the iPhone 6 Plus is a viable option for many people.

Display

The large screen that the iPhone 6 Plus uses is significantly larger than ever before, measuring 5.5 inches, but it is certainly not the largest smartphone on the market. This phone is the first one to feature a full HD 1920 x 1080 display, compared to that of the iPhone 6, which only offers a 750 x 1334 resolution. The iPhone 6 Plus also boasts a 401PPI display, making it the clear and obvious winner with regards to overall clarity.

Design

Although the fact that the iPhone 6 Plus is a big phone may be a deterrent for some consumers, it does have a great overall design. It measures 158.1mm x 77.8mm x 7.1mm, weighing a total of 172g. There is no doubt that this phone is wider, heavier, and taller than many of its competitors, including the LG G3, but the extra weight is to be expected with its premium metal body. While the 6 Plus does feel significantly more bulky in the hand, some people may find that they will adjust to it eventually.

Interface

The iPhone 6 Plus uses the latest version of Apple's mobile operating system, iOS 8, which has brought with it a number of updates and improvements that consumers are sure to appreciate and find useful. The latest version of this mobile OS has fixed a lot of the bugs that came with the previous version, and there are even some new apps as well as features for users to enjoy. The app setup on the main screen of the phone is still the same and very familiar, though users will have two different icon and text sizes to choose from.

Performance

The overall performance of the iPhone 6 Plus is quite impressive. With its 1.39 GHz dual-core A8 processor and 1GB of RAM, this phone is definitely a performance powerhouse. Although the specs of this phone may not seem that impressive to some, the technology that this phone uses is state-of-the-art for smartphones and Apple does an amazing job of integrating its iOS with the internal components of the phone.

Camera

This phone comes with an 8MP iSight camera on the rear and a 1.2 MP front FaceTime HD snapper on the front, providing users with better quality pictures and videos. The lens on this camera is covered with a layer of sapphire glass, making it extra durable.
